

Athletic Conditioning Appointments

TOPS Veterinary Rehabilitation is offering Underwater and Land Treadmill sessions to healthy active dogs. A release from the regular veterinarian will be needed to begin the program.

Sessions will be scheduled during the following hours
Thursdays: 6:00pm - 9:00pm (Staff Asst. - Tracey)
or by scheduled appointment during the week.

Sessions are no longer than 25 minutes in length. The dog will start the session by doing a 10 minute (total) swim, and may increase in time each session depending on how rapid the dog progresses.



Information --

- Sessions are no longer than 25 minutes in length, allowing a 5 minute interval for coming in and out of pool.
- Timeliness is important. If the owner is late for an appointment, the session will still end at it's original scheduled time slot, no extension of time will be given.
- Owner is responsible for canceling an appointment at least 24 hours in advance.
- There will not be a doctor present during these sessions. If there is any question as to the dog's condition at the time of the appointment, the dog should not swim.
- Owners will be responsible for drying (hand or air) their own dogs.
- Appointment scheduling will be done in advance during normal business hours.
- Sessions will be paid for in advance of the scheduled appointment – owners will be sold a ten session punch card for \$330.00 for under water treadmill, and \$165.00 for land treadmill. The punch cards are not designed to mix sessions.
- The owner can purchase a punch card for a second dog for an additional \$110.00 for the same treatment, scheduled to be done at the same time. This means that the first dog and the second dog will both, but individually, use the same piece of equipment in the same 25 minute period.
- Owner can pay by credit card (in person or over the phone) or pay by check (in person or by mail), in advance of the scheduled appointment.
- Owner can pick up the punch card at the first session – we will not mail them out.
- Owner is also responsible for bringing the punch card to each session in order to do the swim.
- We will need proof of vaccines and a health clearance from the owner's regular vet stating the dog(s) is cleared to swim. This should be faxed in advance of the first appointment.
